Diabetes mellitus treatment for use in dogs and cats

COBACTAN (cefquinome)
Broad-spectrum antibiotic range against infectious diseases for use in cattle, swine and horses

EXSPOT (permethrin)
Antiparasitic drug against fleas and ticks for use in dogs

GONAZON (azagly nafarelin)
Gonadotropin-releasing hormone analogue for fertility management in dogs and fish

LEVENTA (levothyroxine)
Treatment for hypothyroidism in dogs

MASTIPLAN (cefapirin + prednisolone)
Broad-spectrum antibiotic with anti-inflammatory activity for treatment of mastitis in lactating dairy cows

NUFLOR/AQUAFLO (florfenicol)
Broad-spectrum antibiotic range for use in cattle, swine and fish

OPTIMMUNE (cyclosporine)
Eye ointment for treatment of keratitis in dogs

OTOMAX/MOMETAMAX (gentamicin + betamethasone + clotrimazole)
Otic ointment for treatment of acute ear infections in dogs

PANACUR/SAFE-GUARD (fenbendazole)
Broad-spectrum anthelmintic drug for use in many animal species

POSATEX (orbifloxacin + mometasone furoate + posaconazole)
Ear drops for treatment of ear infections in dogs

RECEPTAL (buserelin)
Gonadotropin-releasing hormone agonist for fertility management in cattle and horses

REGUMATE/MATRIX/FOLLIPLAN (altrenogest)
Progestogen for fertility management in swine and horses

RESFLOR (florfenicol + flunixin meglumine)
Broad-spectrum antibiotic in combination with a non-steroidal anti-inflammatory drug for use in cattle

REVALOR (trenbolone + estradiol)
Steroidal anabolic implants to improve production efficiencies in beef cattle

SCALIBOR (deltamethrin)
